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THE COVENANTS

### **OLD COVENANT**

 Sign = 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath Keeping = physical rest day 1 day / week

### **SEAL OF GOD: 7TH DAY SABBATH**

**Ex 20:8-12** The Sabbath Commandment to keep it holy .. no work ... in memorial of Creation ... hallowed ... set apart for holy use ... blessed.



The Cross of Jesus Christ is the dividing line between the two Covenants.

### **NEW COVENANT**

Sign = Baptism of the Holy Spirit = spiritual rest day

### **SEAL OF GOD: HOLY SPIRIT**

In **Eph 1:13, 14** In him you also, when you had heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and had believed in him, were marked with the seal of the promised Holy Spirit; this is the pledge of our inheritance towards redemption as God's own people, to the praise of his glory.

**CONTEXT:** Harriet, my wife and I were brought up as 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> generation Seventh Day Adventist Christians (SDA). It was a bit like Old Testament Jews with the New Testament added on. As a result of our upbringing, we had an innate understanding of what the main tenets of the SDA belief were. At that time there was a strong emphasis on keeping the Ten Commandments and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming of Christ. Unknowing it was a very legalistic outlook.

In the mid 1970's, the Gospel began to be emphasised. ie. Jesus as our Redeemer has fulfilled all the requirements of the Law and our responsibility was to simply follow Him ... grace not law.

This emphasis on the Gospel alone lead to a worldwide conflict between the traditionalists and the Gospel reformers. In 1982, the World Administration of the Church sided with the traditionalists and one of the key reformers Dr. Desmond Ford from Australia (Head of Theology of the Tertiary Training College at the Avondale College), was disfellowshipped. Subsequently, in 1983, Harriet and I plus a whole generation like us plus 10% of the pastors worldwide left the Adventist Church altogether. It has taken the church over twenty five years to come around to where we all were in the early 1980's. They now see themselves like other Christians.

The major consequence for us has been an emphasis on our relationship with Jesus Christ and a strong understanding of the Old Covenant and the New Covenant. See the comparisons below.

> The O.C. cannot be used to judge the N.C. as N.C. transcends the O.C. ie. you cannot quote the O. C. eg. Isa 8:20: saying "To the Law and Testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, it is because there is no light in them". The prophet Isaiah was referring to those who sought guidance from wizards and Spirit mediums. He was not referring to those who do not keep a Seventh Day Sabbath.
